Tuesdays

Tennis with Marcy's Tennis Academy@ 3:30-4:30 (Grades K-5)

Feb 23 – Mar 30

Come, learn & play the lifetime sport of tennis! Students will master the fundamentals of the forehand, backhand, volleys, serve, & overhead smash while playing fun-filled games & drills. Students must bring their own tennis racket or may purchase a Junior tennis racket from the academy for \$30

Krazy Kool Legos with Krazy Kool Creations 3:30-4:30 (Grades K-2)

Feb 23 - Apr 13

Legos are a great way to build teamwork, learn negotiating skills, make new friends, be creative, learn speaking in front of a group, and fine tune motor skills. Krazy Kool Legos consists of building Lego projects each class. The students will be split into groups of 3-5 children to work together on a project. There is a theme each class for each group to work on. At the end of building time, each group tells the other students about what they have made and how they have made it.

Lego Robotics - Roaming Rover 3:30 - 4:30 (Grade 3-5)

Lego Mindstorms presents children with hands-on robotic activities. They will use the familiar LEGO brick to create robots by building around a mini-computer which they can program using computer software. We will be building RCX vehicles and learning how to use computer software to program the vehicles to roam and go around obstacles.

Feb 25 - Apr 15

Mr. Cavallaro and Mr. Strychalsky return with this popular program. The children enjoy those games they just can't get enough of in Gym class including: Bench Ball, Castle Ball, Border Patrol, Capture the Flag, Mission Impossible. *(45 max per class)*

Pottery with Daphne Watson Blackwell 3:30-4:30 (Grades 3-5)

Feb 26 - Apr 9

Explore the exciting medium of clay; forming works by hand, decoration & glazing techniques. White earthenware clay will be used. Instruction is geared to inspire each student and is given in an environment that is relaxed, informal and creatively fun! The teaching philosophy is to enable the students to express themselves as fully as possible in their own way. The workshop will introduce two hand-building forms, Pinch and Slab methods. Each session will include a demonstration, discussion & group instruction of the techniques. Students will make their own personalized cup, bowl or basket and either a pencil holder or vase to bring home!
