Dear Parents/Guardians:

In February, we communicated to you that Trumbull High School was adjusting the graduation performance policy. There were several reasons for this, including: the State of Connecticut's mandate that CAPT testing results be integrated by the district into a graduation performance requirement; the link with the Commissioner of Education/State Department of Education's restructuring thoughts concerning secondary education; and our ongoing efforts to achieve the highest possible academic standards.

After further discussions with the Superintendent, it was decided that we would **not** make modifications to the graduation policy for the class of 2010 but continue to seek future dialogue within the district as well as garnering further feedback from the State Department of Education in the future. This pause will reduce the possibility of Trumbull High School implementing any changes which would not align with the State of Connecticut's objectives. We will continue to discuss possible changes to our procedures next year.

Accordingly, consistent with general guidelines from the state, the CAPT performance level required by Trumbull High School of its students for graduation will **REMAIN** at "level 3," proficient. As a school, we still will strive to meet the higher "goal" target. We also will continue to provide those students not meeting proficiency with supportive help to achieve the CAPT numeracy and literary skills necessary to meet the Trumbull High graduation requirements.
