We are planning to do some work in school this February break that will entail the removal of some materials that contain asbestos. This work must be completed before repairs or renovations to this area can begin. It is very important to understand that the school is safe. The materials that will be removed are in good condition and are not causing any exposure or threat to human health.

We plan to remove floor tile and mastic from M-22, M-23, the instrument storage area, practice rooms (A, B, & C), the vestibules, and small adjacent areas near the band room, drafting room M-9, drafting room M-10, the drafting storage room, the reproduction room, and the fine arts storage room. We have arranged for an asbestos removal contractor licensed by the State of Connecticut to remove the tile and mastic. During the process of removing these materials, the area of work will be contained and sealed so that no particles or dust escapes the containment. No one will be allowed access to these areas when the work is performed.

Another environmental contractor, AMC Environmental, LLC, will have State of Connecticut licensed personnel on site to monitor the abatement contractor's work. They will perform air quality tests to document that no asbestos fibers are in the air. Also, air quality tests will be performed when each area is completed to ensure that those areas are safe.

All work will be performed in compliance with State and Federal Regulations governing asbestos abatement in schools.
