

Welcome to Trumbull High School!

Upon entering Trumbull High School, students will be experiencing a new world. Inside, there are many opportunities and options for students in grades nine through twelve. The student population is broken into three different houses according to alphabetical order. Each house has a house principal, along with a team of teachers. About 88% of the teachers hold master's degrees, sixth year degrees, professional degrees, and/or doctoral degrees. Trumbull High provides students with educated, wise, and excellent teachers who are constantly helping their students, whether it is academically or socially. Our teachers are willing to help students during their free periods in order to make the students' high school experience the best possible one.

Students are offered a large variety of courses. Honors and Advanced Placement courses are available, along with an assortment of electives. Trumbull High believes in assisting students for the future.

Aside from academics, Trumbull High School offers many different extracurricular activities. Whether it is a sports team or a club, there is something for everyone. There are many clubs that range in interest level. If a student is not content with the present selection of clubs, they are more than encouraged to create their own club.

Another point of interest at the school is the many classrooms. The classrooms at Trumbull High are organized into three halls: A-Hall, B-Hall, and C-Hall. Each hall has about 20 classrooms. If the room number is below 20, the room is downstairs. If the number is above 20, the room is upstairs. (Ex. A-12 is downstairs, A-22 is upstairs).

You will find that many teachers of the same department will be located in the same hall. For example, many Social Studies teachers can be found in A-Hall, many English teachers can be found in B-Hall, and many World Language teachers can be found in C-Hall. Also, all science rooms are located upstairs.

Classrooms are also located in M-Hall, as well as the newly constructed classrooms around the stairwells, which opened in 2007. The classrooms in M-Hall are dedicated mainly to music, art, special education, and electives. Chorus, Orchestra, and Band are located down this way. CADD, Automotive Fundamentals, and Fashion and Textiles can also be found in this part of the building. In addition, the Continuing Education Offices are located in M19 and the Special Education Office is in this wing as well.

As you look left out of the main office, you will notice multiple showcases displaying our school's accomplishments over the years.

The showcases are filled with trophies and team awards that have been awarded to Trumbull High athletes since it was established in 1961. The plaques and pictures are those of recognized athletes at Trumbull High. There are also departmental showcases here as well.

Turn to the right and continue down the Hallway of Champions where you will find the nurse's office located on the right side of the hall.

The nurse's office is an area where students can go when feeling ill. The THS nurses are always ready for any problem that you may have, whether it is a paper cut or a broken ankle. The nursing staff includes Ms. Dawn Tichy, Mrs. Daisy Benedict, and Mrs. Celeste Miraglia.

Upon exiting the nurse's office, continue down the Hallway of Champions where you will come upon the Gymnasium. Take a right; you will pass the ticket booth on your left. You enter the boys' locker room hallway where, on your right, you will end up at the secretary's office of Athletic Director, Michael Herbst. His office is located straight ahead.

Coach Herbst is in charge of all the sports teams, organizes all our athletic team games, orders all of our uniforms, and keeps everything in line. For more information, or if you have a question

As you turn around and walk out of the double doors after exiting Coach Herbst's office, you will pass the ticket booth again, this time on your right. Walk past the gym and the Faculty Dining Room will be located on your left and the girl's locker rooms will be located behind the two double doors on your right.

The cafeteria, or as we call it, the commons, will be located on your left and the senior lounge will be located on your right.

The commons is where students get their lunch during their lunch period with their choice of a deli sandwich or wrap, salads, or hot lunch foods. Underclassmen enjoy their lunch in the commons while the seniors have the privilege to lounge in the new senior lounge located on the C house side of the commons.

Go straight through the double doors, and you will see a hallway to your left, stairs to your right and a hallway with orange lockers ahead. This hallway is C hallway. Go through that hallway and go straight. In the middle of the Hallway, on your right, you will see two offices, which are the C House Offices.

As you continue going straight down C-Hall, you will come across the staircase to your right and to your left you will see a hallway with blue lockers. This is B Hall.

The B House office and B House guidance are on your right hand side in the middle of the hallway; the office is the first door, and the guidance office is the second door.

A house includes all students whose last names begin with the letters A-F.

As you get to the end of A Hallway, you will notice a staircase to your right and to your left you will see a small hallway with blue lockers; this is the Lower Media Hallway. As you walk through this hallway, you will notice a series of offices on the right side.

The offices of the Dean of Students and the House Disciplinarian are located here. Dean Pijar's phone number is (203)452-4568, and Mr. McLaughlin's phone number is (203)452-4528. The career center, overseen by Ms. Shirley Tyszka, is located next to the Dean's Office and across from the media center.

As you continue down this hallway, you will notice the Media Center on your left hand-side.

This is the Clare M. Hampford Trumbull High Media Center. It is equipped for video, the Internet, other electronic media, and, of course, book needs. The media center is the school's information source.

As you enter, the librarian desk will be to your right and a "seminar room" to your left. Mrs. Pazik runs the front desk and the secretary, Mrs. Kantorowski, would be happy to help you with any concerns and needs. Keep walking and you will see the computers for student use to your left, supervised by Miss Cimmino. Also located on the left hand side is the yearbook office where Mrs. Berescik and her staff of yearbook members work diligently to produce our outstanding award-winning yearbooks every year. On your right is the copy machine. You will find books everywhere. Tables are located in the middle area for students to study and read. Near the tables are the desks of the Media Specialist, Mr. Neenan. Upstairs, the teachers' area is found. Since the stairs are only accessible by teachers, if you need to see a teacher in a certain department (math, science, world language, and social studies) you will need to exit the library and take a staircase upstairs to enter through the doors that are located at the same location as downstairs. At the far end of the upstairs media center are classrooms and offices located across from each other. The media center is open from 7:30AM - 3:15PM Tuesday, Thursday and Friday and 7:30AM - 8:00PM Monday and Wednesday.

Once you exit the Media Center and go left, you will come across the school store in the Lower Media Corridor. At the school store, students can find healthy snacks and other essential needs. Also, resources and information for their permit tests, Drivers Education, and driving tests can be found at the school store as well. Next to the school store is the security office. Their phone number is (203) 452-4576. Once you get to the end of the hallway, go back towards the commons, cut through the commons, and once you reach the other side, make a left and proceed on.
