New updates related to our current school closure are below. All prior communications can be found on the TPS website (www.trumbullps.org).


- All student medication that had been left in Nurses' Offices was retrieved today by Lynn Steinbrick, Town Director of Nursing. Tomorrow, Fri., March 20, the Nursing Department will be onsite at Trumbull High School from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. to return medication to parents/guardians of those students. Distribution will be at the front entrance (Door 1) of Trumbull High School. Please look for school nursing staff. Parents/guardians must show identification at the time of pickup. If a parent/guardian is unable to pick up the medication, an adult (over the age of 18) may pick up the medication, but the adult must bring a letter with the signature of the parent/guardian indicating the specific name of the person picking up the medication; the person picking up the medication must show identification matching the name on the letter.
- Families without devices to access digital content, and/or without Internet access, are urged to contact the District office at 203-452-4336; TPS will provide devices, and/or hard-copy printed packets, as necessary. We have distributed nearly 200 devices to date.
- All distance learning details, for general education and special education students, are posted on the TPS website (www.trumbullps.org).
- For the duration of the closure of the Trumbull Public Schools, meals will continue to be provided to any Trumbull Public Schools students who would like to pick up a grab-and-go lunch and breakfast. This is offered to all household members aged 18 and younger, as long as one child in the household is enrolled in any Trumbull Public School. Please check the TPS website (www.trumbullps.org) for more details; today, we served nearly 500 meals.
- Tomorrow, Trumbull Community Television will tape and then broadcast a second session with Christina Hefele, Director of Digital Learning, and me; the session will focus on additional details of the goals and methods of our distance learning plan. Please e-mail any questions you would like us to address.

No surprise, the Town of Trumbull and Trumbull Public Schools are working as a very strong community in this uncharted time.
