

Trumbull Public Schools Elementary Strings Instruction, 2020-21

All grades 3-5 TPS learners, both virtual and in-school, are eligible to learn to play a stringed instrument, regardless of previous experience. (Please note that students may choose strings or band, but not both.)

Strings instruction is \$125 per student per year; it may be paid in two installments of \$62.50. (The Superintendent of Schools may grant a waiver of the fee which will be based on need. Please contact the Superintendent's Office at 203-452-4301 or dfaiella@trumbullps.org for additional information.)
