

# Reading Is Thinking

Here are some comprehension questions to ask your child after reading.

## Encourage your child to:

- Think carefully
- Restate the question
- Use at least 2 specific details from the story
- Explain how these details support his/her thinking
- 🐱 What are the most important parts/scenes? How does this part fit into the whole story?
- 🐱 What trait/s would you use to describe (character)? What actions/words lead you to this?
- 🐱 Can you summarize what you read?
- 🐱 What is a major message in the book/story? How can you apply this message to your own life?
- 🐱 Which part of the story was the most surprising? Interesting? Why?
- 🐱 What signposts did you notice in the book? How did they help you to better understand it?
- 🐱 What is the genre of this book? How do you know?
- 🐱 What is the theme/lesson of this book? Have you read any books with the same theme? (Compare/contrast)
- 🐱 What made you want to keep reading? How did the author make it interesting?

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
