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TPS Administrators,


I am pleased to summarize here the adjustments to the TPS Administrator Supervision, Evaluation, Professional Learning Plan (TEVAL) for 2020-21. These adjustments, made possible by CSDE this unprecedented year, were endorsed last week by the TPD Professional Development & Evaluation Committee (PDEC).

There are three adjustments:

- (1) Goals and IAGD objectives for this year should focus on the reopening of schools, supporting the well-being of staff and students, supporting distance teaching and learning, and/or supporting the health and safety of students, staff, and the school community. There should be at least one goal and at least two indicators of accomplishment.
- (2) All tenured administrators¹ will participate in two school site observations and two artifact reviews.
- (3) There will be no summative rating for administrators this year. The end-of-year forms will include a self-assessment from the administrator, and a narrative summary from the evaluator.
