

LOAN OF TEXTBOOKS TO NONPUBLIC SCHOOL PUPILS

Policy

The Board of Education authorizes the lending of textbooks, free of charge, to any Trumbull resident attending a nonpublic school located in Trumbull – kindergarten through grade 12.

The following conditions must apply for approval of requests for the loan of textbooks:

- a. only titles that have been adopted by the Board of Education may be loaned
- b. only copies not needed by pupils in the Trumbull Public Schools may be loaned
- c. only copies available with no additional purchasing may be loaned
- d. only textbooks needed for use for at least half of a school year may be loaned

The Board of Education reserves the right to recall at any time any textbooks on loan when they may be needed for use by pupils in the Trumbull Public Schools. All textbooks on loan shall terminate at the end of the school year for which they are granted, and returned in the same condition in which they were loaned. However, the Administration may renew a loan subject to a review of and the fulfillment of the conditions required. Textbooks which are not returned, or returned damaged beyond ordinary wear, shall be subject to those charges found in the Trumbull Board of Education policy, Care of Instructional Materials (Policy Code: JNA).
