

## SCHOOL TRAFFIC AND PARKING REGULATIONS

### Policy

The traffic and parking regulations of each school shall be designed to insure the safety of students, staff, parents, and community.

### Regulations

1. Each school shall have posted and/or painted signs indicating proper traffic plan.
2. Each school shall disseminate information on this policy, stressing that extreme caution be exercised when entering or leaving school grounds.
3. Designated parking and non-parking areas shall be clearly marked. Vehicles shall never be parked in fire zones.
4. A limit of 15 m.p.h. has been approved by the Board of Education on all school property, unless posted otherwise, and pedestrians always have the right of way.
5. During arrival and dismissal times, drivers are not to interfere with buses and are expected to drop the students off or pick them up at designated areas. In no instance should a driver pass a bus that is displaying flashing lights and/or stop signal.
