

SECURITY

Policy Statement

The Board of Education recognizes that district employees, students, visitors and others present on District property are entitled to work and study under safe and secure conditions. Every reasonable precaution will be taken to protect their security and their property.

These precautions may include, but are not limited to, school officials searching student's lockers where there exists "reasonable suspicion" of weapons or other contraband.

Although each building administrator is responsible for building security he/she should work cooperatively with school personnel, students, the School Resource Officer (SRO), and the parent community to make certain the environment is secure at all times. Staff and students should be encouraged to report anything of an unusual nature to the school administration. Administration should implement security procedures befitting the particular school and its unique nature. If these procedures are of an unusual or prolonged nature, students, parents and central administration should be kept informed.
