

- Grades 3-5 students who have been participating this year in lessons for band and strings instruments will receive e-mails tomorrow from their specific music teachers, who have worked this week to set up specialized Google Classrooms to continue their instruction; we are very excited for the continuation of this important learning!
- PreK students' Trimester 2 progress reports will be mailed next week, on Fri., April 3, by Long Hill staff.
- Grades K-5 students' Trimester 2 report cards will be mailed next week, on Fri., April 3, by Long Hill staff.
- Grades 6-8 students' Trimester 2 report cards will be published on Infinite Campus on Fri., April 3.
- For next year's Trumbull High School students:
 - Students currently in grades 9, 10, & 11: THS counselors are working now with current grades 9, 10, & 11 students on their 2020-21 course recommendations and requests; students in those grades should be alert to their counselor's Google Classroom and related e-mails.
 - Students currently in grade 8: Details on the 2020-21 course recommendation and request process for current grade 8 students will be forthcoming in a separate eBlast tomorrow. The timeline will allow all grade 8 students and their families to view additional online resources on the course recommendation and request process. Our initial timeline has been extended based on the current school closure, and grade 8 students and families will have at least until mid-April to give feedback on their 2020-21 requests.
