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


The latest updates related to our current school closure are below. All links below are clickable in this letter as posted on the TPS website (www.trumbullps.org).

- To help evaluate our TPS distance learning to date, we ask parents/guardians to complete this feedback survey: <https://forms.gle/F5m2axm4NWepmnNU8>. We ask that one parent complete this survey for each child in the Trumbull Public Schools. The survey will be active through the end of today. Your feedback will be used to guide our future work.
- Earlier today, Trumbull Community Television taped a session that included two special virtual guests: Elizabeth Capobianco (THS math teacher) and Pablo Sevilla (THS Spanish teacher). Elizabeth & Pablo focused on distance learning for high school students. We particularly recommend this broadcast for those families and students at the high school level! - We are pleased to provide the third edition of our Distance Learning Parent Newsletters. A newsletter is available for each level: Elementary, Middle, and High School. This week's newsletters provide some useful tips on navigating a Chromebook, how to help your student with Google Classroom, and how to use Read&Write/TextHelp to support students. You will notice that there is a link in the upper right-hand corner of the webpage to several "Student Help Tutorials" for your family's reference.
- Grab-and-go meal distribution for TPS families will continue for all upcoming TPS vacation days, including Good Friday. Meal distribution is offered to all household members aged 18 and younger, as long as one child in the household is enrolled in any Trumbull Public School; per USDA & CSDE guidelines, there is no link to economic need during this extended school closure. Between 10:00 a.m. & 12:00 p.m., families can receive a free lunch for that day, and also a free breakfast for the following day. Curbside meal distribution is at the front entrance (Door 1) of Trumbull High School (72 Strobel Road), and we encourage all interested families to participate.
