
Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s):

This letter includes the latest updates from our office related to our current school closure.


- A Regular Meeting of the Board of Education will be held on Tuesday, June 9, at 7:00 p.m. via audio/video conferencing. Please click here for the agenda and supporting documentation; the agenda includes details on how to access the Meeting, and how to provide comments to the Board.
- Our middle and high school principals have eBlasted to families information related to students' return of TPS items, which will occur next week at each school. Please review that information carefully so that all textbooks, library books, etc., can be returned.
- We have been asked by families about potential changes to the requirement that students receive a health assessment by June 1 of grades 3, 6, and 9, particularly given that appointments for "well" children may be limited both now and in the future weeks. The Connecticut State Department of Education and the State Department of Public Health have been working to develop ways to facilitate all parents/guardians meeting these requirements in a timely manner. We will communicate specific information on this topic as we receive it from CSDE/DPH.
- As you have likely heard in the media, regulations related to COVID-19 may require various changes to be made to all types of school-based routines in the fall. Trumbull Public Schools will be convening a committee of representative stakeholders, including parents, to help study the issues that arise over the next weeks and make informed recommendations for any necessary action items. If you are interesting in serving as a parent representative on this committee, please reach out to Dr. Budd's office at 203-452-4336. For those who wish to participate but who are not selected for the committee, we also anticipate regular feedback opportunities as information unfolds.
- For the parents/guardians of students entering grade 12: Because students in grade 11 were unable to participate in the CT SAT School Day on March 25, students in grade 12 will be able to participate in a free SAT administration during the regular school day on Wed., Oct. 14, 2020. This free SAT can be reported by students in the college admissions process.
