EMPLOYEE'S SERVICE IN THE GUARD OR RESERVE

Policy Statement

Should any employee who, as a part of such employee's service in the armed forces of the State of Connecticut, the reserve component of the armed forces of the United States, or the National Guard of any other state, be ordered to perform military duty, including meetings or drills, during regular working hours, the Trumbull Board of Education shall allow such employee leave of absence for such purpose. No such employee shall be subjected, directly or indirectly, to any loss or reduction of vacation or holiday privileges by reason of such absence, or be prejudiced by reason of such absence with reference to promotion or continuance in office or employment, or to reappointment to office or reemployment.
