REPORTS AND RECORDS OF SCHOOL TRANSPORTATION SAFETY COMPLAINTS

Policy Statement

The Superintendent of Schools or his/her designee shall:

- 1. Develop and implement procedures for reporting all complaints relative to school transportation safety, including complaints about bus drivers;
- 2. Maintain a written record of all such complaints;
- 3. Within thirty days of the close of school each year, submit to the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles a report containing all complaints received within the previous twelve-month period; and
- 4. Within ten days of its occurrence, make a written report to the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles, on the form prescribed by the Commissioner, of the circumstances of any accident, within the Superintendent's jurisdiction and knowledge, involving a motor vehicle and any student pedestrian at, or in the immediate vicinity of, a designated school bus stop.
