## Agenda Item II-Preliminary Business

C. Public Comment

Frank Squiccimaro read correspondence thanking the Board for its support of an activity at the elementary schools and urged parents to reach out to the First Selectmen regarding this year's budget request. THS senior Saige Annakie is an advocate for diversity and spoke about the need for black and brown history via curriculum and community awareness.
D. Superintendent Report - Dr. Semmel reported:

- A communication was sent to parents of student athletes informing them that they can now have 2 guests attend athletic events.
- Congratulations to THS senior Grace Xiong who has been notified by the National Merit Scholarship Corporation that she is a finalist.
- Dr. Semmel thanked parents for participating in the lunch program and encouraged families to pick up meals for their students to help reduce our monthly losses in Food Services. The USDA provides reimbursement for every student meal we provide.
- We hope to have good news regarding our budget request for insurance, as cost projections appear to be less than anticipated. Mr. Hendrickson will continue to provide updates.

C. National High School Athletic Coaches Association (NHSACA) Finalist Marcellino Petroccio The Board is excited to celebrate our Head Coach for the THS football team and his nomination for NHSACA finalist, Marcellino Petroccio. Mrs. Timpanelli thanked him for his genuine caring attitude, his stellar coaching skills and extended best wishes for the future. Mr. Petroccio stated that he is honored to be nominated and thankful for the support of the Board and administration. He is so happy to represent the Town of Trumbull and proud of the athletes and all their hard work.
D. Reopening Update - Dr. Semmel updated the Board:

- The Reopening Committee continues to meet every Thursday to discuss concerns and provide updates. Dr. Semmel participates in weekly meetings with the Department of Health and the Connecticut Department of Education to stay informed of the best practices for our students and staff staying safe and the reopening of our schools.
- We have received excellent news that beginning on March 1, 2021, all building staff will be eligible to receive the vaccine. Dr. Semmel is working with the Trumbull Department of Health to provide the best opportunities for all staff to be vaccinated.
- The district is exploring the best way to bring students back to our classrooms on Wednesdays beginning the third trimester during the week of March 22, 2021. There is overwhelming support from teachers and administrators to keep Wednesdays half day to give staff the much-needed time for professional development and collaboration.
E. Social Justice Update

Dr. Iwanicki reported on the news that TPS is partnering with the State of Education Resource Center (SERC) to provide our students with equitable practices in our educational system needed to ensure success for every student in TPS. This will be a long-term commitment by the district that will include reflection on our current practices and help ensure equitable and culturally relevant education for the students and families that we serve.

The meeting was called to order at 4:30 pm.
The minutes of the January 21,2021 meeting were approved.
Mr. Hendrickson reviewed the financial reports as of January 21, 2021, including:
a. Fund 001 the BOE General Fund
b. Fund 009 the Town's Fund for Non-Public school expenditures
c. Fund 100 Student Activities
d. Fund 200 State and Federal grants
e. Fund 205 Special Revenue Funds
f. Fund 210 Food Service
g. Fund 300 Scholarships formerly Expendable Trust

Mr. Hendrickson stated that the cumulative percentage (46.9\%) of budget spent year-to-date is less than in the past two years. He addressed specific budget line items.

Also, Mr. Hendrickson said that this week the District received \$1,090,446.92 of its Coronavirus Relief Fund (CRF) allocation of $\$ 2.1$ million. The District also received its first Excess Cost Reimbursement (ECR) totaling $\$ 823,768.00$; this is approximately $75 \%$ of the full year's payment. The second (of two) payments will be received in May.

He pointed out that the last two pages of the report listed all the COVID related expenses, and said that Trumbull's CRF allocation would not cover all the District's COVID related expenses.

Mr. Hendrickson said that the Lunch Account's loss in January was $\$ 20,207$ down from $\$ 96,984$ in December. The cumulative deficit year-to-date in this account is $\$ 521,592$.

After accounting for timing issues, Mr. Hendrickson projected a deficit of $\$ 171,357$ in Special Revenue Accounts. The Elementary Strings/Band and Pre-School are the major contributors to this projected deficit.

All grants have been funded and only the IDEA Part B Sec 611 grant has a small deficit which Mr. Hendrickson and Dr. Hartman are addressing.

Under other business, Mr. Hendrickson did the following:

1) Updated the Committee on the Business Office's progress on the Operational Review recommendations.
2) In accordance with the Operational Review, he requested the first transfer of this fiscal year. It was approved, and forwarded to the Board of Education for consideration at their next meeting.
3) Following up on Mr. Kerr's request from the last Committee meeting, he showed the Committee the financials for the Elementary Strings / Band Special Revenue Fund from MUNIS.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:25 pm.
