School Gate Guardian - Red Kiosks

Prior to my arrival, the district had purchased safety kiosks from School Gate Guardian. Over the past several months we have been installing these kiosks in the vestibules at each school and increasing our communication capabilities between the main office/security team and each vestibule. While we are still waiting for some parts (yes, supply chain issues) we are ready to fully implement the new system beginning on Monday, February 28. by our safety team, to better understand how this system adds another layer of safety at each school and the procedures you will need to follow if you visit any one of our schools.
